### France -

- 1 Sauvignon Blanc Cheval d'Or, Vin de Pays d'Oc 2010**      £3.95      £5.20      £15.50  
Ripe, citrus fruit flavours with a lemony finish makes this a lovely, quaffable dry white.
- 2 Domaine La Salette, Cotes de Gascogne 2010**      £17.50  
Made from Colombard this is light, crisp and aromatic with a touch of pear fruit and apple blossom on the nose. Soft and fresh, an interesting alternative to Sauvignon.
- 3 Gewürztraminer, Domaine Gocker, Alsace 2009**      £6.15      £7.85      £22.95  
Pungently fruity and aromatic but a light, delicate bodied wine. It is luscious but still dry and has the classic Gewürztraminer flavours of lychee and rose petals.
- 4 Macon Fuissé, JP Paquet, Burgundy 2008**      £27.50  
Macon is full of apricot fruit flavours on the nose and palate. Medium bodied deliciously soft and round in the mouth, a wonderfully well balanced white burgundy.
- 5 Chablis, Domaine de Bois d'Yver, Burgundy 2010**      £28.50  
Tropical fruit aromas with a hint of almond on the nose. Classic Chablis with zingy acidity and a flinty, mineral character. This Chablis is organic. Also in half bottle section.
- 6 Pouilly Fumé, Karine Lauverjat, Loire Valley 2010**      £32.95  
Floral, mineral aromas and concentrated flavours of citrus fruit, grass and nettles with crisp acidity and lingering finish.

### Italy -

- 7 Pinot Grigio, Colpo di Fortuna, Veneto 2010/11**      £4.75      £5.75      £16.50  
Light, fresh and crisp with delicate aromas of peach. Zesty with a crisp finish.
- 8 Gavi 'Salluvii', Castellari Bergaglio, Piedmont 2010**      £19.95  
Light, delicate, soft and unctuous with aromas of peaches, honeysuckle and a touch of nuttiness in the background.

### South Africa -

- 9 Chenin Blanc Groote Post, Darling Hills 2010**      £19.50  
A bright, full flavoured Chenin with green apple, guava and pure tropical fruit flavours.

### Iberia -

- 10 Rioja Blanco' Gentes de Forastia', Spain 2010**      £5.15      £6.15      £17.50  
Made from the Viura grape this has a youthful herbaceous nose with subtle hints of spice.
- 11 Vinho Verde, Adega de Moncao, Portugal 2010**      £17.95  
Wonderful Vinho Verde it is light, a little spritzy, lemon and lime fruit, super fresh and clean.

### The Antipodes -

- 12 Chardonnay 'Boomerang Tree', South Eastern Australia 2010**      £4.95      £5.95      £16.75  
Medium bodied, ripe tropical & citrus fruit with a touch of vanilla.
- 13 Sauvignon Blanc 'Infamous Goose', Marlborough, New Zealand 2011**      £6.65      £8.75      £24.95

Pungent, herbaceous nose with citrus and hints of passion fruit and elderflower. Crisp and dry with classic Marlborough gooseberry and grass clipping characteristics.

- 14 **Viognier Private Reserve Morton Estate,** £28.50

**Hawkes Bay, New Zealand 2008/09**

This fantastic Viognier boasts big peach and apricot aromas mixed with citrus and floral notes, it is a powerhouse of perfume and flavour with a finish that lingers on and on.

- 15 **Chardonnay 'Durham' Allanmere,** £31.95

**Hunter Valley, Australia 2009**

Top Australian Chardonnay; this big wine exhibits a myriad of flavours such as tropical fruit, banana, butterscotch and hazel nuts with hints vanilla and toast in the background.

## The Americas -

- 16 **Sauvignon Blanc Reserve 'Santa Digna',** £18.95

**Miguel Torres, Chile 2010**

A fresh, floral wine that shows intriguing notes of exotic fruit such as lychee and grapefruit. Softer and a little more subtle than other new world Sauvignons Blancs.

- 17 **Torrontes 'Tierra de Luna', Bodega Lurton,** £19.95

**Mendoza, Argentina 2010**

Torrontes is Argentina's speciality white grape; flowery aromas with hints of Muscat and roses on the nose. Light and soft with medium acidity and a just a touch off dry.

- 18 **Pinot Gris, Cline Estate, USA 2010** £26.50

This luscious wine has aromatic characters of ripe apple, pear and vanilla. The lush texture and mid palate succulence make for an unctuous, mouth watering wine.

## Red Wines -

### France -

- 19 **Syrah Les Cazalets, Vin de Pays d'Oc 2009** £3.95      £5.20      £15.50

Soft and supple packed full of cherry and bramble fruit with a touch of spice.

- 20 **Domaine Le Cazal, Minervois 2009** £19.95

An unusual and wonderful medium to full bodied red wine from the Minervois. Rich violet, bramble and damson fruit combine with hints of heather, nutmeg and spice.

- 21 **Côtes du Rhône, Domaine Corne-Loup,** £5.95      £7.25      £19.95

**Rhône Valley 2010**

Soft Rhône with lots of ripe cherry fruit, spice, black pepper and a touch of earth.

- 22 **Beaujolais 'Quatre Saisons',** £26.50

**Domaine Chasselay 2009**

A real hand crafted Beaujolais – light and fragrant with intense crushed cherry aromas. This wine is organic.

- 23 **Chateau La Fleur Boireau, Montagne** £26.95

**Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux 2004**

Medium to full bodied beautifully balanced, ripe, blackberry and violet flavours with overtones of cedar and cigar box. Soft supple tannins and a long finish.

- 24 **Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Domaine Michel** £27.95

**Juillot, Burgundy 2008**

On the nose there are hints of plum, spice with a touch of bay leaf. Lots of red fruit flavours on the palate with a dash of burgundy gaminess finished off with soft ripe tannins.

- 25 **Chateau Cissac, Cru Bourgeois,** £43.50

**Haut-Medoc, Bordeaux 2004**

Very dense and opaque purple crimson colour. Good blueberry fruit, quite aromatic with violet scents but also meaty notes. Rich and full with good tannins and vanilla overtones.

## Italy -

- 26 **Rosso Passo, Cantine Lenotti,** £19.50

## Veneto, Italy 2009

50% Merlot and 50% Sangiovese. This wine is all about fruit. It is light bodied and aromatic bursting with Morello cherry and redcurrant flavours, soft with very light tannins.

- 27 **Chianti 'Il Cortile' 2008, Castello di Poppiano,** £26.95  
**Tuscany, Italy**

Crushed cherry and blackberry fruit aromas on the nose. This Chianti has a lovely balance between rich, spicy fruit and firm tannic structure. Also in half bottle section.

## Iberia -

- 28 **Rioja 'Gentes de Forastia', Spain 2010** £5.15 £6.15 £17.20

A barrage of black fruit flavours in the mouth against a backdrop of toast, vanilla and spice.

- 29 **Periquita Tinto, Setubal, Portugal 2009** £22.95

A lovely blend of native grape types this has a sweet core of red fruits very juicy and soft.

- 30 **Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Beronia, Spain 2007** £29.95

Hedonistic Rioja...fine and elegant bouquet with toasted aromas and touches of leather and sweet fleshy fruit. Smooth and elegant, robust but not too heavy with a finish that lingers.

## South Africa -

- 31 **Pinotage Franschhoek Cellar, 2009** £17.95

Mulberry and plum aromas with hints of chocolate and that classic Pinotage smoked earth.

## The Antipodes -

- 32 **Shiraz Boomerang Tree, Australia 2010** £4.75 £5.75 £16.50

Medium bodied, jammy, red berry Shiraz with a touch of pepper.

- 33 **Pinot Noir Morton Estate, Marlborough,** £26.50  
**New Zealand 2008**

Aromatic, silky and medium bodied with berry fruits prominent while thyme herb characters contribute to a lengthy, fine grained finish.

- 34 **Cabernet Sauvignon 'The Cigar',** £33.95  
**Coonawarra, Australia 2009**

The wine was matured for 14 months French oak hogsheads. There are floral high tones of violets and lavender are underscored by bass notes of cherries and dark chocolate, superb.

## The Americas -

- 35 **Merlot Ramirana, Chile 2010** £4.95 £5.95 £16.75

Medium to full bodied Merlot full of soft plummy fruit and a hint of violet.

- 36 **Old Vine Zinfandel, Scotto Vineyards,** £21.95  
**Lodi, USA 2008**

A rich wine with dark chocolate and plum flavours, and hints of cassis, vanilla and spice.

- 37 **Malbec 'Newen', Fin del Mundo,** £6.15 £7.85 £22.95  
**Patagonia, Argentina 2010**

Damson and bramble fruit flavours and hints of vanilla and coconut. Rich and balanced.

- 38 **Reserva Carmenere, TerraNoble, Chile 2010** £23.95

On the nose fine ripe fig and red berry aromas with chocolate notes. On the palate it has an intense fruit sensation with delicate coffee notes and a hint of violet and nutmeg.

 100% Pinot Noir. Light and delicate with enticing strawberry and rose petal flavours.

### White -

- 52 **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough,** £39  
**New Zealand 2010**  
 Aromas of grapefruit and other citrus, gooseberry and sweet thyme. Vibrant acidity balances the rich grapefruit, lime and gooseberry flavours in a generous, lively palate.
- 53 **Meursault, Domaine Henri Delagrangé,** £39  
**Burgundy 2009**  
 This Meursault has a bouquet of hawthorn, acacia and lime, with mineral and citrus fruit overtones. A rich, full wine in the mouth with lovely hints of toast and vanilla.
- 54 **Chassagne Montrachet,** £75  
**Domaine Marc Morey, Burgundy 2008**  
 Chassagne has sensational fruit aromas combined with delicate floral scents and spicy nuances. It is a rich, full wine with sensational multi dimensional character.

### Red -

- 55 **Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine de** £45  
**Fontavin, Rhone Valley 2007**  
 A medium bodied style dominated by smooth, mouth filling Grenache and sweet, earthy Syrah, there are notes of red berry fruit, coffee and generous layers of spicy complexity.
- 56 **Barolo, Fratelli Alessandria,** £55  
**Piedmont, Italy 2005**  
 Elegant and graceful, both its bouquet and taste are well balanced with unctuous berry fruit

flavours mingling with spicy, nutty, cinnamon notes. Irresistible it caresses the palate...

- 57 **Volnay, Domaine Henri Delagrangé,** £60  
**Burgundy 2007**

Medium bodied, the palate offers complex plump, fleshy red fruits with subtle vanilla oak flavours, balanced by supple, round tannins. A well harmonious wine with a long finish.

- 58 **Chateau Duluc, Branaire Ducru,** £60  
**Saint Julien, Bordeaux 2005**

The nose is a sumptuous aroma of raspberry liqueur interwoven with blueberries, and spring flowers. Layers of fruit on the palate, fabulous purity powerful and rich.

- 59 **Chateau Figeac 1er Grand Cru Classé,** £135  
**Saint Emilion, Bordeaux 1998**

This wine is all about finesse and elegance; it is well balanced, silky with blackcurrant fruit and toasty, oak, overtones and hints of cassis, cedar wood and tobacco. Bottle age has meant the tannins are wonderfully integrated, result...drinking perfection.
